Notes for Applicants

I. General Information

Applications are invited for applying undergraduate admissions for 2024/25 Entry. Apart from local applicants applying solely on the strength of Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) examination results, all individuals should submit their application directly to HKUST via the <a href="https://hkust.nih.gov/hkust/hkus

Local applicants applying to the University solely on the strength of HKDSE examination results should submit their admissions application through the <u>Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS)</u>. JUPAS applicants with outstanding non-academic achievements nominated under the School Nominations Direct Admissions Scheme (SNDAS) should submit their admissions application via <u>UGOAS</u>.

The University reserves the right to alter or change the curriculum of any program at any time without prior notice.

II. Application Submission

Generally, each applicant should submit <u>ONE</u> application for admissions only in the same academic year, through any one of the admissions schemes. Duplicate applications received by the University through the same or different admissions scheme(s) will not be considered and all application fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Applicants who are currently enrolled in a full-time bachelor's degree program funded by the University Grants Committee (UGC) in a local tertiary institution should submit their applications directly to HKUST using the <u>UGOAS</u>. Please note however that following UGC's guidelines, inter-institutional transfer is generally discouraged.

Double registration in a program at another tertiary institution, local or overseas, is not allowed. Current undergraduate students of the University who wish to apply for a transfer to another program should contact the Academic Registry Office, instead of submitting an admissions application.

Any incorrect or misrepresented information given in the application will lead to disqualification and any offer(s) made by the University will be withdrawn. Further legal actions will be taken if necessary.

III. Local and Non-local Status of Applicants

According to the Education Bureau (EDB), "non-local students", for the purpose of admissions to post-secondary programs, are defined as follows:

Students holding the following document issued by the Immigration Department of the HKSAR:

- a. Student visa/entry permit; or
- b. Visa/entry permit under the Immigration Arrangement for Non-local Graduates; or
- c. Dependent visa/entry permit and were 18 years old or above when they were issued with such visa/entry permit.

For holders of Recognizance Form, please clarify with the EDB their local/non-local status.

Applicants are required to report to the Undergraduate Recruitment and Admissions Office immediately should there be any changes on their identity documents, which affect their status as local / non-local or their nationality, after submission of application. Any offers made under the initial admissions scheme may be revoked in connection with such changes, and applicants will be re-considered in competition with other eligible applicants under the appropriate admissions scheme.

If any application data, including local / non-local status and nationality, is found to be incorrect or misleading, any offers made may be revoked and all fees paid will not be refunded.

IV. Eligibility for Application

To be considered for admissions, applicants must satisfy the General Admissions Requirement, English Language Admissions Requirement and Program-specific Admissions Requirement set by the University.

To facilitate the application review process, applicants should complete all relevant sections of the application form and upload supporting documents as appropriate.

V. Application Fee

The online application fee is HK\$450 for 2024/25 Entry. The application fee, once paid, is non-refundable and non-transferable irrespective of whether the application is successful or not.

The University accepts online payment of application fee by either VISA, MasterCard, AliPay and WeChat Pay through the UGOAS at the time of application submission. Please refer to the "Guide to HKUST Online Application" or "科大本科课程网上申请指引" if you have any problem.

An application will not be processed until the application fee is fully paid and the status of the application is changed to "Submitted". Payment status of the application fee is shown in the "Payments and Submission" section of each online application profile.

VI. Points to Note After Submission of Application

If the submission is successful, the status of the application will change to "Submitted" on the "My Application" page of <u>UGOAS</u> and the applicant will receive an acknowledgement email through the email account in the application. Subsequent changes to the application status will also be reflected on the "My Application" page.

Other than the "My Application" page, the University will contact applicants only through the email account quoted in the application. Applicants should regularly check for emails from the University and visit the <u>UGOAS</u> for messages and updates. Applicants should also ensure their contact information are correct and valid at all times. For data privacy reasons, the University will address the enquiries from the applicants directly.

Applicants should upload all necessary documentary evidence promptly and update their online application, especially in cases of new qualifications and certificates obtained or at the request of the University. Delays in providing such additional information may affect the processing of the application and therefore also the application results.

Applicants should quote their full name and application number in all enquiries and correspondences.

VII. Admissions and Registration

Undergraduate students admitted to HKUST should observe the University's <u>Academic Regulations</u> and make reference to the <u>Undergraduate Student Guide</u> as necessary. Successful applicants receiving an offer of admission should also follow the instruction provided in the offer letter and the University's website before

they can register with the HKUST. For applicants with SNDAS offer, once they accept the offer, their JUPAS applications will automatically be removed from the system. If they decline the offer, their SNDAS offer will be voided and their JUPAS applications will remain unaffected.

In addition, previous student of HKUST who is seeking re-admissions to the University should have settled all outstanding payment from previous studies in order to proceed to new program registration. Double registration in a program at another tertiary institution, local or overseas, is not allowed.

VIII. Collection of Information and Data Privacy

The University shall observe the <u>Personal Information Collection Statement</u> and the <u>University Data Privacy Policy Statement</u> in handling the data collected in the application, and may allow the school quoted in the academic reference section of respective application to have access to the information contained in, and the status of, these applications, unless otherwise advised by the applicant.

乙) 递交入学申请

每位申请人在同一学年只能提交一份入学申请表。若申请人透过相同或不相同的入学途径重复提交申请表,大学将不予考虑,所有已缴交的申请费均不予退还及转让。

申请人若为大学教育资助委员会(教资会)资助的本地全日制学士学位课程学生,必须使用 UGOAS 直接向大学提交申请。然而,根据教资会的指引,申请人不鼓励以此方法转校或转读其他 课程。申请人亦需留意,科大本科生不能同时拥有两个课程的学籍,不论其中一个课程是否由另一个本地或海外院校提供(双重学籍)。如拟转读其他课程之在学科大学生,应联络科大教务处 查询,而非提交入学申请。

如申请人提供任何虚假或误导性资料,大学会取消其申请及录取资格。如有需要,大学会采取法律行动。

丙) 本地与非本地生之定义

教育局就专上课程录取非本地学生的定义如下:

持有以下由香港特区入境事务处签发的证件的学生,均视为非本地生:

- 一) 学生签证/进入许可;或
- 二) 在非本地毕业生留港/回港就业安排下的签证;或
- 三)受养人签证/进入许可证(获签发签证/进入许可证时已年满 18 岁的人士) 持有由入境事务处签发的担保书(俗称「行街纸」)的学生,请向教育局查证其是否为本地生。

如申请人于递交入学申请后,需要变更其身份证明文件并影响到其本地生/非本地生资格,须立 即通知本处。基于其本地生/非本地生资格的变动,本处可能会撤销已发出的录取资格,并按其 变更后的身份重新考虑其入学申请。

如申请人提供任何虚假或误导性资料,包括但不限于本地生/非本地生资格、国藉,大学会取消其申请及录取资格,所有已缴款项将不予退还。

丁)申请资格

申请人必须同时符合大学之一般入学要求、英语入学要求和课程特定入学要求才会被考虑录取。 为免影响申请审核程序,申请表的所有部分必须清楚填写,并上传适当文件。

戊) 申请费

2024/25 年度科大网上入学申请费为港币 **450** 元正。不论申请成功与否,所有已缴交的申请费均不予退还及转让。

申请人在 UGOAS 提交申请时,可使用 VISA、MasterCard、支付宝或微信支付缴交申请费。如有疑问,请参阅"Guide to HKUST Online Application"或"科大本科课程网上申请指引"。

在未缴交费用及申请状态尚未转为"申请已成功递交"之前,申请将不获处理。有关费用的付款情况将在申请表内"申请费"一栏显示。

己) 递交申请后的注意事项

如申请递交成功,"申请状况"页面中的状态会更新为"申请已成功递交"。申请人将透过 UGOAS 中的电子邮件帐户收到确认电子邮件,申请的后续更改将反映在"申请状况"页面中。

除"申请状况"页面外,大学只会透过申请表所提供的电邮与申请人联系。申请人须定期查阅大学发出的电子邮件,并到大学 <u>UGOAS</u> 获取信息和最新资讯。申请人须确保所提供的联络资料是有效并正确的。基于个人资料私隐原因,大学只会回应申请人直接提出的查询。

申请人应尽快上传所有必须的文件并在 <u>UGOAS</u>内更新申请表内的资料,特别是持有新学历、新证书或大学要求的文件时。延迟提供相关资讯,只会影响申请处理程序及结果。

申请人须在所有查询和信件中引用其全名和申请号码。

庚) 入学与注册

香港科技大学之本科生需遵守科大的学业规则(<u>Academic Regulations</u>)并参考本科生指引(<u>Undergraduate Student Guide</u>)。获录取的申请人必须按录取通知书及大学网站内的指示接受录取并跟进,方能获邀办理注册手续。获录取的 SNDAS 申请人若接受录取,其 JUPAS 申请会自

动从 JUPAS 系统中删除。若申请人不接受 SNDAS 录取,其 SNDAS 录取将作废,而其 JUPAS 申请則不受影响。

此外,欲申请再次入读科大之旧生,必先结清对大学之欠款,方可注册入读新课程。科大之本科生不能拥有双重学籍。

辛) 个人资料的收集及处理

大学在处理从申请中收集的个人资料时,将遵守<u>《收集个人资料声明》和《大学资料私隐政策声明》</u>,并允許申请人於申请表 academic reference(学术推荐)部分所填报的学校,查阅其申请资料(申请人指定不允許者除外)。
